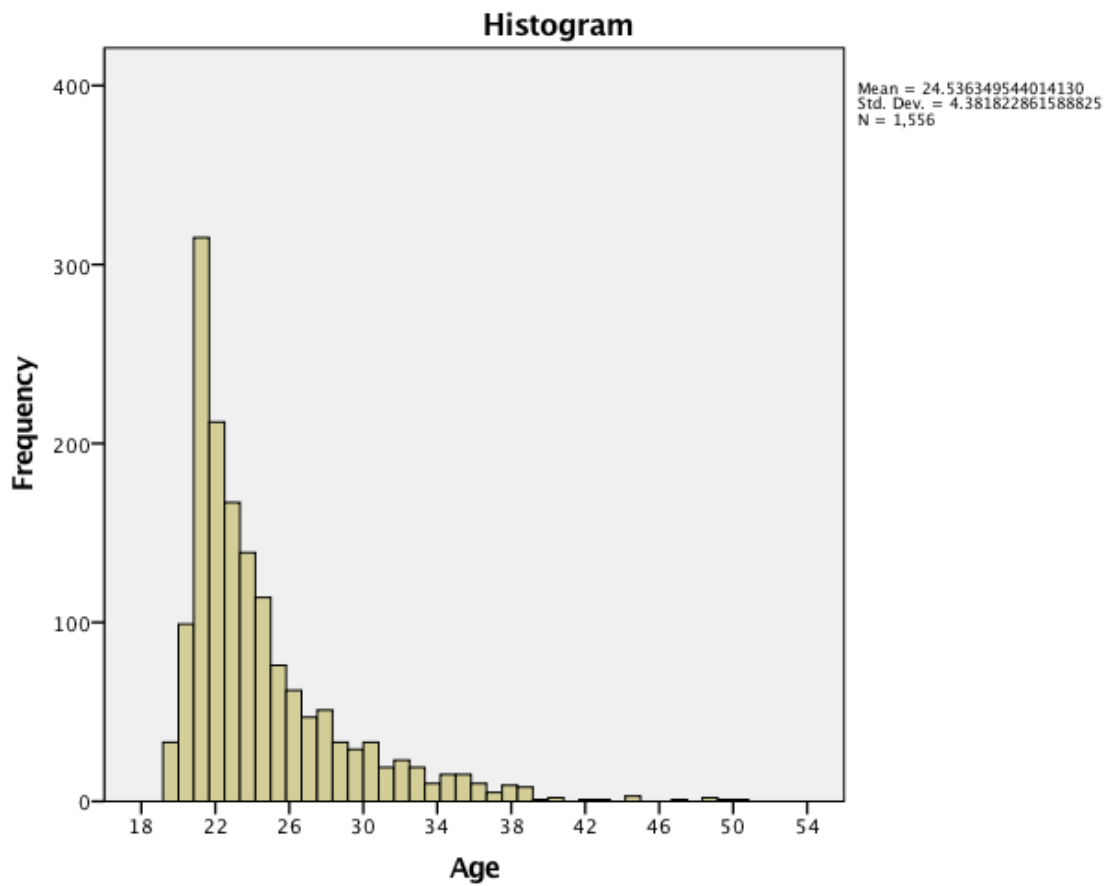

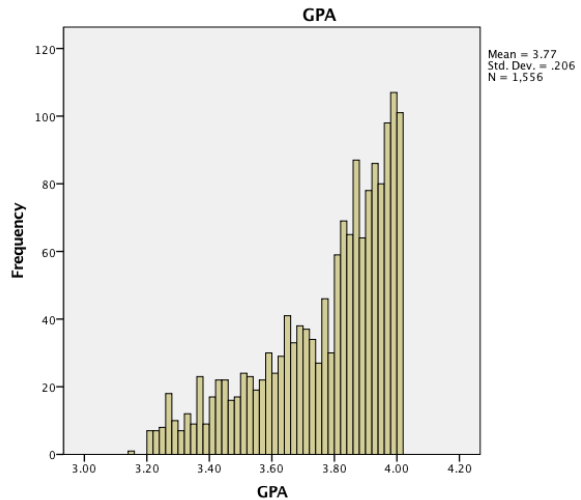
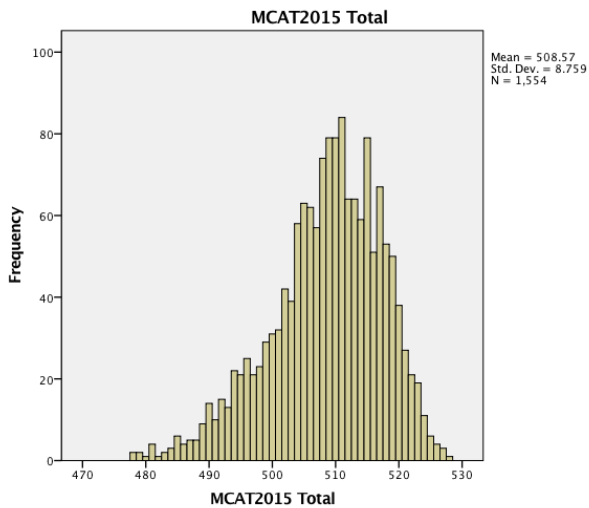
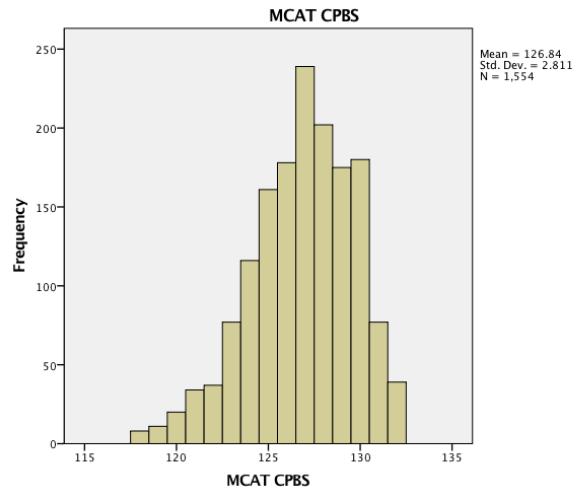
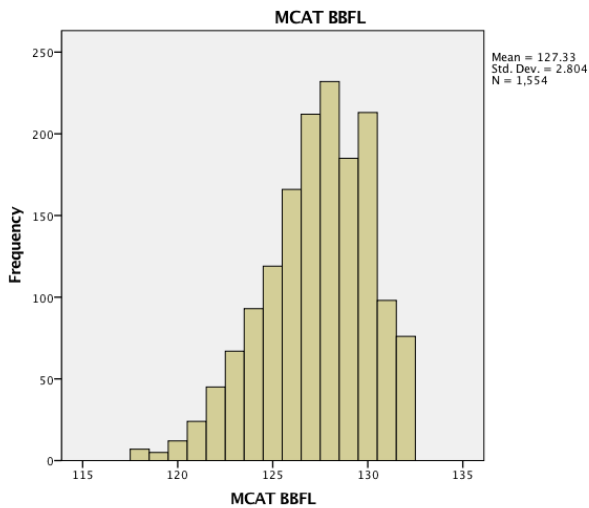
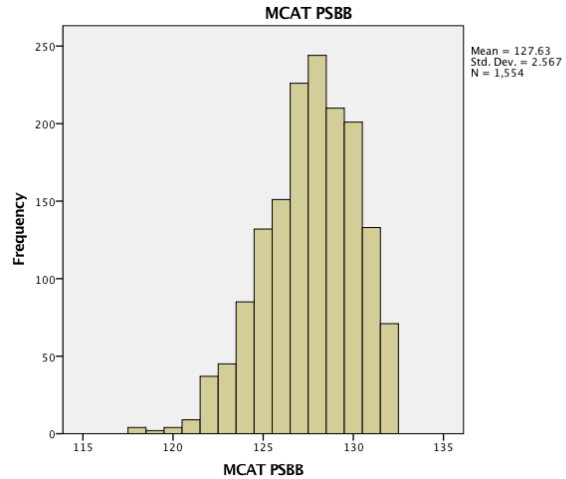
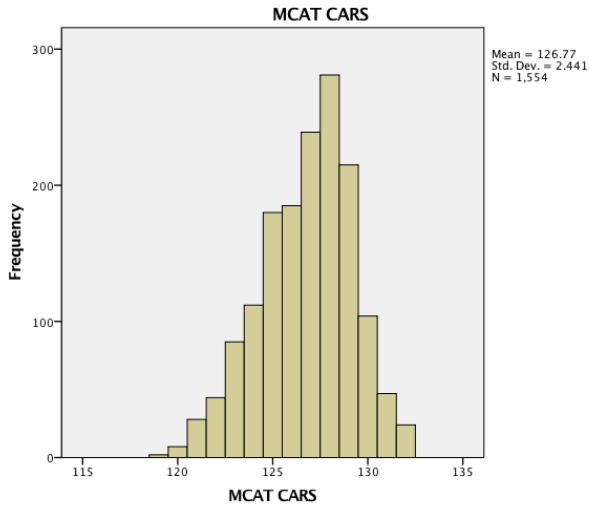

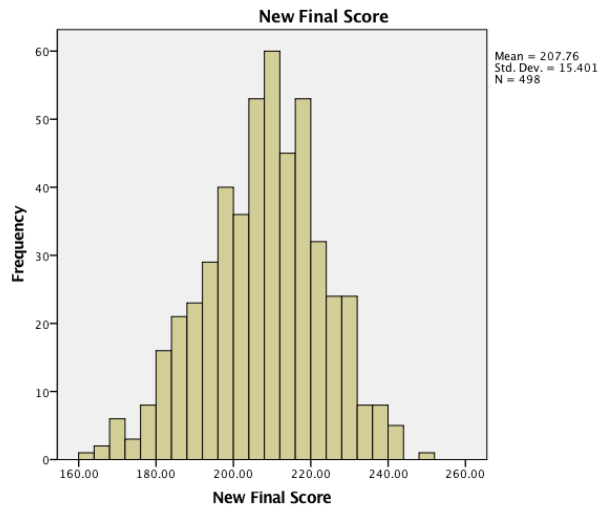
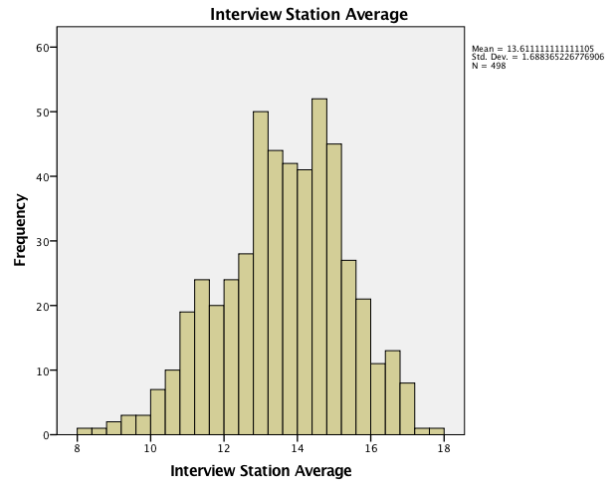
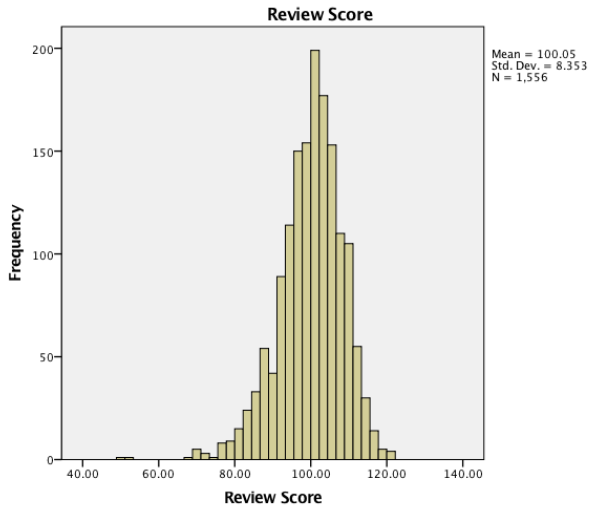
Distribution of Age of Applicants
